



## Terms and conditions of a Wollongong College Australia (WCA) scholarship

Effective for all WCA offers issued 1st October 2009 to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2010 for all WCA courses commencing 1 January 2010 to July 2010.

1. To be eligible to receive a scholarship with Wollongong College Australia (WCA) you must be a citizen of an eligible country AND must be residing in that country at the time of application (e.g. if the offer is made for the territory of Hong Kong, the holder of a Chinese passport living in Hong Kong is NOT eligible; the holder of a Hong Kong identity card or British passport living or studying in China is NOT eligible). Scholarships are not available to those already studying or living in Australia.
2. Where you extend your course after commencing a course at WCA, the tuition fee for the period of the extension will be at the full tuition rate (NOTE: exception applies for Thailand for English Language Courses – see table above).
3. The scholarship must be taken up for the session in which it is offered. Where an applicant defers the course commencement date to a starting date after the expiry of the offer, the scholarship may not be re-offered.
4. This scholarship scheme supersedes all previous fee discount arrangements, **except for**:
  - a. students currently enrolled on one of these schemes; or
  - b. applicants who accept an offer for a course commencing in 2010 based on an offer letter issued before 31 August 2009 with tuition fees made on the basis of existing discount schemes (including the current English language fee structure of \$300 per week for courses of 15 weeks or more); or
  - c. those who have a full tuition fee waiver.
5. The offer of the scholarship will be included with the offer letter for the course for any eligible student, and will show the net fee, the amount of the scholarship and the full fee for the course. A note on the offer letter will direct the applicant to the conditions of the scholarship which will be posted on the WCA website.
6. Applications must be received one month prior to the commencement of your intended start session.
7. You are advised that you will be contacted by WCA and asked to be a WCA Ambassador. If you choose not to be a WCA Ambassador this does not affect your eligibility to hold a WCA scholarship. This is outlined in the Terms of Scholarship. An extract on the specific terms regarding WCA Ambassador's is provided below.

### WCA Ambassador

1. As a Wollongong College Australia ("WCA") scholarship holder I understand that I will be asked to assist WCA by being a WCA Ambassador. I understand that I do not have to agree to be a WCA Ambassador and if I choose not to be this will not affect my eligibility to hold a WCA scholarship in any way.
2. A WCA Ambassador is an official representative of WCA who agrees to positively promote and represent WCA.
3. As a WCA Ambassador I may be asked to actively participate in the promotion of WCA. My role as a WCA Ambassador may involve, but is not limited to:
  - a) participating in market research;
  - b) attending one-on-one meetings to mentor WCA students;



- c) attending welcome events with new students;
  - d) attending meetings with guests such as agents and delegates; and
  - e) writing reports or testimonials to be used by WCA for promotional purposes.
4. I acknowledge that as a WCA Ambassador I must at all times conduct myself professionally and responsibly.
